A griculture plays a vital role in the world's economy, and farmers continually strive to improve their productivity and efficiency. Access to appropriate machinery is crucial for achieving these goals, as it can significantly reduce labour requirements and increase overall output. However, owning and maintaining



agricultural machinery can be expensive and impractical for many small-scale farmers. This is where Custom Hiring Centres (CHCs) come into the picture, providing a sustainable solution to address the machinery needs of farmers. Objectives

- To make available various farm machinery / equipments to small and marginal farmers
- To offset the adverse economies of scale due to high cost of individual ownership
- To improve mechanization in places with low farm power availability
- To provide hiring services for various agricultural machinery/implements applied for different operations.
- To expand mechanized activities during cropping seasons in large areas especially in small and marginal holdings.
- To provide hiring services for various high value crop specific machines applied for different operations.

Establishment of CHC

Custom Hiring Centre (CHC) was established at Hengbung NICRA village sponsored by ICAR-CRIDA, Hyderabad in 2011-12. CHC- Hengbung is run by Village Climate Resilient Management Committee (VCRMC) constituted under NICRA. Different farm machineries are made available on hire to the farmers at nominal charge by CHC.

Advantages of CHC

- Provides access to small and marginal farmers to costly farm machinery.
- Reduces drudgery
- Reduction in cost of cultivation
- Work opportunities to skilled labour
